For over 40 years, Fort Clark Days has taken place at Fort Clark Springs in Brackettville, Texas. More than 100 Living historians will be demonstrating skills from the past and educating our visitors about the history of southwest Texas. In addition to our living historians, we will have arts & crafts and food vendors. Fort Clark Days is sponsored by Fort Clark Springs Community Council, a 501(c)3 organization.

Rules, regulations and details:

- 1. The Arts & Crafts portion of this event is Saturday only, from 9am to 5pm. Friday is designated for schools
- 2. This is a juried event. No commercial products or flea market items allowed.
- 3. At least two weeks prior to the event, artisans will receive an email including site confirmation and detailed set-up information.
- 4. Artisans must supply his/her own tables, display material, and seating. If you are paying for power you must supply your own lights and fans, and extension cords. Booth set-up will be on pavement, and staking is not allowed. You must bring weights to secure your tent.
- 5. Booth must be open and staffed for the duration of the event. After unloading, vehicles will NOT be permitted to remain in the exhibit space and must be moved out of the area 1/2 hour <u>before the event</u> is scheduled to start. Vehicles may not enter and begin breaking down until after event is over.
- 6. Artisans are responsible for collecting and paying all sale taxes.
- 7. Fort Clark Days endeavors to have a broad representation of quality artisans, and therefore reserves the right to limit the number of artists per category.
- 8. There is no smoking within the Arts and Crafts area.
- 9. Application Deadline: Applications must be received by February 3, 2020
- 10. Cancellation policy: 50% of your booth fee will be refunded if you cancel prior to February 10th.
